#### Message from the Vice Dean for Academic Affairs

The College of Applied Medical Sciences is one of the newest colleges of King Faisal University yet it steadily being recognized in the health system of the region through the exceptional competencies of its graduates. With the current pandemic causing unprecedented disruptions of educational systems worldwide, the College unremittingly pursues to fulfill its mission to respond to the Kingdom's demand for world-class health professionals.

This Strategic Plan outlines our unified goal to provide even more health program options to prospective students even as we continue to strengthen our flagship programs thru continuous quality improvement and international accreditation.

The College prides itself in the unique expertise of its faculty. We seek to maintain our high research output even as we further strengthen our faculty through rigorous faculty development programs. We envision the College taking a more active part in increasing the university ranking by enhancing the culture of scientific research among faculty and students alike.





#### **Brief history of the College of Applied Medical Sciences**

The College of Applied Medical Sciences (CAMS) is one of the fifteen colleges of King Faisal University (KFU), one of the largest educational institutions in the eastern region of the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia. CAMS is located in the main campus of KFU in Hofuf, Al-Ahsa.

The College of Applied Medical Sciences was established following the decision issued by the Minister of Higher Education No. A/1689 dated 20/8/1432H citing the Royal Decree No. MB/5088 of 7/8/1432H approving the establishment of the College of Applied Medical Sciences to qualify graduates to obtain a Bachelor of Science Degree in Applied Medical Sciences specializations. This decision is in line with the recommendation of the World Health Organization (WHO) put forward a few years ago to the ministries of health in different countries regarding the minimum qualification of the paramedical staff and also in line with the Saudi Vision 2020 along strengthening the skills of Saudi health care professionals. This recommendation stipulates that the bachelor degree is the minimum qualification for employment at hospital facilities. The implementation of the recommendation was to start in 2010.

The College currently offers two degree programs: Bachelor of Science in Nursing and Bachelor of Science in Public Health. Beginning AY 2020 – 2021, the College will begin admitting students to two new programs: Bachelor of Science in Clinical Nutrition and Bachelor of Science in Health Informatics.

#### The CAMS Strategic Plan

The College of Applied Medical Sciences Strategic Plan embodies the College's vision, mission and goals for the next five academic years (2020 - 2024) following the opening of its two pioneering programs, BS Nursing and BS Public Health in 2013 and 2014, respectively and the upcoming welcoming of students to the new programs that will begin in AY 2020 – 2021, BS Health Informatics and BS Clinical Nutrition.

The Plan is anchored on the recently launched King Faisal University Strategic Plan for 2020 – 2024. Its development drew inspiration from specific provisions of Saudi Vision 2030 that place emphasis on empowerment of Saudi nationals and health for the community. It also considered provisions of the Strategic Plan of the Saudi Ministry of Health. The Saudi Arabian Qualification Framework (and later, the National Qualification Framework) along with three NCAAA documents namely, the Standards for Programs, Self-Evaluation Scales, and Key Performance Indicators, were used as references in developing activities and key performance indicators for the 2020 – 2024 Strategic Plan.

The Strategic Plan draws from the Periodic Program Review conducted in the two academic programs – Nursing and Public Health. Accomplishments and issues that were compiled from the Course Report presentations as well as the Annual Program Report were reviewed in the preparation of this Strategic Plan. Similarly, areas of weaknesses in the programs as well as the college as a whole identified in student surveys were taken into consideration.

As the Nursing and Public Health programs are preparing for international accreditation with their respective accrediting bodies, the standards for eligibility and accreditation requirements have been studied. An important development in the College of Applied Medical Sciences is the opening of two additional programs in AY 2020 – 2021 with plans of opening additional Bachelor and Master Programs.

The Strategic Planning and Decision Support Committee spearheaded groundwork for the development of the CAMS Strategic Plan. The Committee is headed by the College Dean with the Coordinator of the Quality Assurance Unit as Deputy. The different College Committees, headed by their respective Chairpersons, greatly contributed in the preparation of the SWOT Analysis.

This strategic plan was completed at the end of AY 2019 - 2020. Several revisions were undertaken prior to its approval by the College Council on 19/7/1442.




