COURSE DURATION: 3 WEEKS CLINICAL CLERKSHIP

COURSE UNITS: 3 CREDIT HOURS

COURSE OBJECTIVES :

Through this clinical rotation and lectures, it is expected that students will be competent to:

- 1. Take through comprehensive history in a systematic manner from the patient
- 2. Perform through neurological examination in a systematic manner
- 3. Interpret the neurological findings in the context of history and examination and present rational differential diagnosis with justification

MODE OF TEACHING:

Bedside teaching ward rounds, lectures, tutorials, and clinical seminars

EVALUATION:
