Instructions for students in the hospital

- **1.** Arrive on time
- 2. Present yourself neatly dressed and groomed, in the Grey suit and you must wear your white coat with your name badge.
- **3.** Never Look In Files or Reports without Permission.
- **4.** Never perform any examination during your rotation without supervision.
- **5.** Do not ever examine any gynecologic patient in any way when you are alone.
- 6. All the attending activities will be recorded and signed in the log book by the responsible resident or consultant or staff member.
- **7.** Bring your own instruments (stethoscope).
- **8.** The student must also demonstrate a sense of responsibility to patients, colleagues and the health care team.
- 9. If you attend with such behavior, you will presumably have the rapport and trust of the patient and the health care team to get permission to take a new patient history and /or perform exams.
- 10. You should make progress notes for your cases, which are daily notes written to document status of current problems and identifying new problems. Your writing should be legible with attention to detail.

Student Classifications
