**Course Title: INTERNAL MEDICINE II**

**Course Duration: 6 weeks**

**Course Units: 6 credit hours**

**Course Objectives:**

At the completion of the course it is expected that the student will be competent to :

1. Complete history with personal bio-data of the patients in a systematic manner.
2. Perform complete general physical and systematic examination.
3. Come up with differential diagnosis based on history and physical examination.
4. Propose appropriate investigation to substantiate his clinical diagnosis
5. Know the principles of the management of common medical conditions
6. Have good knowledge of the pathogenesis, clinical manifestations, differential diagnosis and management of common medical diseases.
7. Acquire the knowledge of ethics in medicine

During this course lectures related to common diseases of medical specialties will be delivered by the subject experts.
