
Ref: Curriculum Coordination Mechanism at College of Medicine

After completion of the adaptation of the curriculum from the University of Groningen, Netherlands in year 2017, the faculty board of the college has approved to transfer the all-academic activities including blocks and lines under the respective departments as mentioned in attached organogram. There were two layered supervision i.e., General Supervisory Team (GST) and GMCA – coordinators established for coordination of the adaptation of the curriculum, which are abolished and a new system of coordination will be applied.

In new system as per rules & regulation of the King Faisal University, all blocks and lines will work under the supervision of the departments. Therefore, Academic Plan Committee discussed this issue in 3<sup>rd</sup> meeting held on Sunday 19/11/2017 and all members of the Academic Plan Committee have discussed thoroughly the role of departments and came up with this conclusion that there should be a centralized system for coordination of the curriculum activities. Hence, a **curriculum committee** has been established which is comprised of the following chairs/coordinators of the all departments and headed by Dr. Abdulrahman AlMulhem for the supervision of all academic activities at college of medicine, King Faisal University with immediate effect.
