King Saud University's College of Pharmacy was established in 1959 with a female section of the College established in 1982. Both the male and female campuses are equipped with modern technologies in classrooms, as well as with research and teaching laboratories. The College plans to expand both campuses.

The College of Pharmacy at King Saud University instituted the Doctor of Pharmacy Program in 2005. In 2012, 254 students entered the BPharm and PharmD programs with 51 of those students at the PharmD entry level. There are 80 preceptors for APPE and 15 hospitals, 94 community pharmacies, and 4 primary care pharmacies for IPPE.

Near East University's Faculty of Pharmacy was established in 2006, admitting its first class of 45 students in 2007. Current enrollment in the Faculty of Pharmacy is approximately 130 students. The Faculty of Pharmacy building was specifically designed to meet the needs of pharmacy education and is equipped with modern technology. Since the inception of the Faculty, three classes have graduated from the MPharm program.

King Faisal University was founded in 1975 and established a PharmD program in 2002. The program commenced for the 2004-2005 academic year with 25 male students; 27 female students joined the program four years later. Currently, approximately 360 PharmD students enroll each year. The College has relationships with 14 local hospitals and 2 community pharmacy chains as training sites.

Jagadguru Sri Shivarathreshwara College of Pharmacy was founded in 1973. In May 2008, the Ministry of Human Resource Development, Government of India, recognized JSS University, officially uniting the Medical, Dental, and Pharmacy Colleges. JSS Colleges of Pharmacy offer the following programs: BPharm, PharmD, PharmD (Post Baccalaureate), MPharm in twelve specializations, and PhD. During the 2013-2014 school year, JSS Colleges of Pharmacy enrolled a total of 384 students at the Mysore and Ooty campuses.
