Achievements:

1 - New-Faculty Orientation Program (NFOP-2013) on 29th August 2013.

To help new faculty to have a good start and to have smooth and enjoyable work experience at COCP and KFU, the College organized New Faculty Orientation Program (NFOP-2013) on Thursday, Aug 29, 2013, from 1:00 pm to 4:00 pm.

The orientation started with the welcome speech by Dr. Ibrahim Alhaider, Dean, COCP, followed by an introduction to human resources (e.g., benefits, use of information technology/computer orientation, etc.), as well as familiarization to the Islamic/Saudi culture/KFU/College of Clinical Pharmacy organizational culture.

During orientation program, Dr. Afzal Haq Asif Associate Professor, COCP explained the College of Clinical Pharmacy and King Faisal University policies and resources to the new Faculty members. Furthermore, a brief overview of the College, curriculum, academic and assessment program, and professional development were also detailed. Dr Afzal also introduced the Faculty Handbook and explained the Mission, vision and Goals of the College of Clinical Pharmacy, the strategic plan, university Byelaws, promotion and tenure process.

Dr. Shree Harsha, Assistant professor, COCP, delivered the next presentation. 3- Community engagement and professional training lectures.

The committee organized numerous lectures on health issues with the support of faculty members. This was in accordance with COCPs' vision and mission in community engagement and professional training.

3-1-The college's Participation in community Pharmacist's role in diabetes management symposium.

In the framework of the activities carried out by the faculty members of the COCP, the college participated in a symposium on "the community Pharmacist's role in diabetes management". The general directorate for control of genetic and chronic diseases organized the event on 11th September 2013 in Ramada hotel Dammam. In the first session, Dr. Mohammad Zaitoun, Lecturer, Department of Pharmacy Practice gave an introduction to diabetes, its complications and different lines of treatment focusing on the

community Pharmacist's role in management of the disease. In the second session, Dr. Ahmed Sarsour, Lecturer, Pharmacy department focused on different types of insulin, designing an insulin regimen and the proper use of different insulin dosage forms. The symposium was moderated by Dr. Ahmed Al Madani, the training supervisor of the general directorate for control of genetic and chronic diseases and was attended by community Pharmacists from eastern province.

Dr. Mohammad Zaitoun, Lecturer, Department of Pharmacy Practice presented a lecture on "Role of Clinical Pharmacist in Psychiatry ." Dr. AbdulRahman Al Nijadi, Teaching Assistant, Department of Pharmacy Practice and the clerkship students: Sara Al Hussain, Hawraa Al Khamis and Somaya Al Khawaja, also attended the symposium

3-5-Presentation by COCP faculty at Prince Sultan Cardiac center

Dr. Mais Hasan Iflafiel delivered a lecture on Glycoprotein IIb/IIIa antagonists on 24th March 2014 at Prince Sultan Cardiac center, Al-Ahsa. Hospital Medical staff actively participated in the presentation.

The presentation was mainly focused on pharmacokinetics and pharmacodynamics of Glycoprotien IIB/IIIA inhibitors, role of these medications in acute coronary syndrome, and administration with and without PCI

3-6-COCP participation at KFH presentations:

Dr. Amal Abu Alhommos delivered a lecture on Nurse Intervention in Epilepsy on 26th March 2014 at King Fahad Hospital, Al-Ahsa. Hospital nurses participated in the presentation. The presentation includes the introduction to epilepsy, its prevalence in the world, its types and, the First Aid for nurse in epilepsy activity. The bulk of the lecture was on the nurse interventions for epileptic patients in hospital or clinics with health care providers. Finally, there were two published articles that show the important role for Epilepsy Specialist Nurses (ESN) in providing the best patient service and the percentage of shortage for ESN in hospitals.

3-7-COCP faculty participation in seventh symposium of Psychiatric Pharmacy:

In the framework of the activities carried out by the college faculty, Dr. Mohammad



Zaitoun, lecturer of Pharmacy Practice, gave a lecture entitled "Psychotropics in pediatric population: a medication safety perspective" in the seventh symposium of Psychiatric Pharmacy held in Al-Amal complex for Mental Health in Riyadh on Thursday, 10th of Jumada II 1435 the 10th of April 2014. In its three scientific session, the symposium discussed psychotropic medications safety, role of Pharmacist in pediatric psychiatry and recent innovations in pharmacy automation. The symposium was held under the patronage of the director of health affairs in Riyadh region with the participation of Dr. Yousuf Al-Omi general director of pharmaceutical care in the Saudi ministry of health. The scientific program was prepared by 9 lecturers from different Saudi hospitals and universities.

3-8-COCP Participation in MCH organized Symposium:

Dr. Yasir A. Ibrahim, Coordinator, Department of Pharmacy Practice, participated in a symposium entitled "Maximizing Outcome of Appropriate Antibiotic Therapy" and gave a lecture on "The Role of Antibiotics in the Management of Serious Hospital-Acquired Infections in the first session and on "Vancomycin & Aminoglycosides TDM Theoretical View and Applied Practical Cases" during second session. Maternity and Children Hospital (MCH) organized this symposium on 27th April 2014 at Maternity and Children Hospital lecture hall. Many health professionals of MCH (Pharmacist, Pediatrician, General Physician, infectious disease specialists and Nurses) and COCP training students Actively Participated in the symposium. The symposium was focused on

- 1. identification of strategies, which, optimize the dosing of Antimicrobials to maximize clinical outcome from infections
- 2. to reduce the development of antimicrobial resistance including defining the role of newer antibiotic options in treating serious hospital infections caused by emerging gram-negative and gram-positive pathogens and
- 3. the value of therapeutic drug monitoring (TDM) of antibiotic for maximizing killing or inhibition of bacterial growth.



3-9-Lecture on Novel Anticoagulant Medication For Atrial Fibrilation:

Dr. Mais Hasan Iflaifel, Clinical Lecturer, Pharmacy Practice Department delivered a lecture entitled "Novel Anticoagulant Medication For Atrial Fibrilation", on 26th May 2014 at Prince Sultan Cardiac Center Al hasa (PSCCH). Cardiology consultants, specialist, residents, surgeons, pharmacist and nurses of Cardiac Center attended the presentation.

The lecture was mainly focused on new anticoagulants (dabigatran, apixaban, rivaroxaban) mechanism of action and data behind the use of new anticoagulants in atrial fibrillation. Then Dr. Mais discussed about Pharmacokinetics and dynamics for each medication compared to warfarin and how to convert patients from warfarin to new anticoagulants. Finally, Dr. Mais highlighted the evaluation of the overall risks across studies.


