3. Admission Requirements

In addition to what is stated in the university graduate regulations, the educational department adds the following conditions:

- The applicant has a regular bachelor's degree. The program does not accept a bachelor's degree in affiliation or distance education.
- Applicants must obtain 70% or above of the cumulative average in the bachelor's degree in one of the educational specialties.
- Applicants must obtain 70% or above of the cumulative average in the bachelor's degree in any non-educational specialization with the requirement to obtain a general diploma in education with a grade of 70% or above the cumulative average.

- Applicants must obtain 70% or higher in the university's aptitude test, which is evaluated by the National Center for Measurement and Evaluation.
- After the first conditions are met, the applicant is entitled to enter the written test that the department evaluates.
- The applicant must receive at least 70% in the written test. The department council is entitled to amend the percentage in case of non-passing.
- After achieving the first conditions and passing the written test by 70% or higher, the applicant qualifies for an interview that requires passing by 70%.
- Those who passed the personal interview will be ranked in descending order and candidates for admission will be awarded the highest students in the cumulative average in a school diploma.

4. Study Plan

The program includes one track that can be enrolled in the program to obtain a master's degree in education, educational management specialization, which is:

Successfully complete thirty-two units of study as following:

- Five credits (college requirements) for all students applying for the program.
