
Today, it has become evident that creating knowledge and spreading it is a field of competition among nations and peoples of the world in the 21st century.


It is also known that the economies of advanced countries are based, in the first place, on the production of knowledge and on investing this production to fulfill the needs of human communities and achieve their prosperity.











- Work on developing scientific research as a main activity of the university in its different colleges.

- Make the most possible use of advanced scientific medical equipment that can be employed for multiple purposes to serve scientific research and facilitate important and rare medical investigations.







King Faisal University and Scientific Chairs







- Foster a culture of excellence, innovation, and creativity in the university's genres and support their development.

- 5- Develop channels of utilization of the university's assets of human resources, utilities, and equipment and put them in service of the community.












- 4. Developing the university's human (academic and administrative) resources, and adopting on-going training programs to adapt with the requirements of changing into a society of knowledge.




















- Supporting the role of the university in serving the national economy by the investment of knowledge.














Alumni
